 3. He has been associated with and blessed by Sri Kanchi Kamakoti Peetathipathi Sri Mahaswamigal, Santhaveli Mahan Sri Sri Karaisiddhar, Sendamangalam Sri Datta Peetam Sri Krishnananda Brahmendra Avadhootha Swamigal, and Pudukkottai Sri Bhuvaneswari Peetam Sri Pranavananda Saraswathi Swamigal.

 4. At the age of 12, he had the special blessings from Sri Bhuvanananda Nathar (Sri Mantramoorthy Sastrigal, who was the Manthra Sastra Guru to our Kanchi Mahaswamigal) as he has predicted the bright spiritual future by his Jnana Dhrishti.
